On Your Bulletin Cover: “Light of the World” (1853) by English artist William Holman Hunt (1827-1910). There was a time when “Light of the World” was the most-viewed painting of all time-- it toured the world to be viewed by some 7 million people, and then was put on public display in Saint Paul’s Cathedral in London to be viewed by many more. The inspiration for the painting is from the book of Revelation 3:20: “*Behold, I stand at the door and knock...*” The painting was considered by many to be the most important and culturally influential rendering of Christ of its time. It became ubiquitous-- it was copied countless times, engraved reproductions were widely hung in nurseries, schools and church buildings, and it inspired several noted musical works. It is rendered in stained glass at the front of Trinity’s sanctuary.
