

Custodian: Trinity United Church

Reporting to the chairperson of the Building and Grounds Committee, the custodian is responsible for the regular cleaning and tidying of the church to ensure that it presents a warm and welcoming environment ensuring the health and safety of the congregation, staff and other users.

The custodian is responsible for the cleaning of washrooms, floors, walls, surfaces, fixtures and appliances using chemicals, soaps, disinfectants and tools necessary to meet requirements. The custodian will assist in other areas of general maintenance as required.

The position is regularly scheduled part time comprising of a four day / 16 hours work week. Work although flexible, must coincide to support and not interfere with activities within the church.

The successful candidate will possess a high school diploma or equivalent diploma, have relevant cleaning experience, WHMIS training with First Aid and CPR as an asset. The successful candidate will produce at their expense, a successful (negative) vulnerable person criminal record check and be willing to update this every two years.
